The Adler Planetarium in Chicago is the first planetarium built outside Europe in 1930. Originally equipped with a ZEISS Model II projector, it was upgraded to a Model III in 1960. In 1970 the projector was replaced with a Model VI that was

in operation for 40 years. In 2011 the projection was fully digitized, and the current system was installed in 2017. Today, the Adler Planetarium offers high-resolution imagery using the most advanced planetarium software.
